Emily Dickinson was a famous American poet.
This is one of her poems::

A Light Exists In Spring

*A Light exists in Spring
Not present on the Year
At any other period
When March is scarcely here*

*A Color stands abroad
On Solitary Fields
That Science cannot overtake
But Human Nature feels.*

Dickinson studied botany from the age of nine. Along with her sister, tended the garden at Homestead. During her lifetime, she assembled a collection of pressed plants in a sixty-six page leather-bound herbarium. It contained 424 pressed flower specimens that she collected, classified, and labeled using the Linnaean system. The Homestead garden was well-known and admired locally in its time.
